

## UK-Banned Sister of Tadley resident wants the right to updates on **Yandex** **360** our father's welfare

Respected Sir

My name is Mohini Hersom, an Indian. I was born in 1958, and my sister, Viju Wortley, born in 1962, lives with her husband, Mr. Stephen Wortley at Mala, Sandy Lane, Pamber Heath. I lived in the UK from 2004-2018, and in 2013, Viju got a conviction against me called harassment without violence. It is useless to say this was trumped-up, because it has not been overturned by the courts.

But the court was skewed, and the plaintiff gave no evidence nor came to court. Based on that, I am prevented from entering the United Kingdom, and was not able to attend Mom's funeral. Dad is 90 and does not have long to live. He lives alone in a 5-bedroom house at RG31. Recently Dad stayed with Viju and Steve after discharge from hospital, and stopped answering the phone. Dad is physically weak and Viju dislikes it if he speaks to me on the phone.

My question is how to get the legal right to know if Dad passes away? Viju wont tell. The Basingstoke police wont help, as it is not their job they said. If Dad stays with Viju in the future I want the legal right to know about my father's welfare. The Basingstoke police said talk to a lawyer but I am sure you wont have any luck. I didn't.

Dad said Viju said Steve was suspended from Atomic Weapons Establishment where he has worked lifelong as a scientist, in 2012, based on suspicious emails coming in for Steve at AWE.co.uk. These emails proved Steve to be a member of a racist party. Steve was re-instated, my father said, after the AWE came up with the first and last name of my boyfriend based in London as sender. Viju told my father she started the criminal conviction against me, to make it look like I am the culprit, so this would not happen again. I am not allowed to meet my boyfriend.

I am sure my boyfriend is not responsible, but we must live under this fake thing. Can anything be done? Can an official or police personnel be requested to investigate? This story dates back to 2012.

I would like to see my Dad before he dies. I would certainly need to know be updated of his welfare by sister if he is under her roof. My Dad is so good and intelligent. He says he has breathing troubles and life is a struggle
