I am one of the daughters of one of your elderly patients. This letter, (which is signed and dated at the bottom of this page and on the last page), contains a photograph of your patient along with mine. I did this hoping to establish that I know the patient and that maybe there is a facial resemblance. In addition, I have enclosed one form of identification and two one-page bank statements. They contain my current address and my former address in the UK. I know that the doctors are not interested in my identification. But I don't want anybody to say I wrote an anonymous letter. I have had a bad experience with someone in the UK, possibly a blood relative, who opens my scanned letter on a computer, deletes my signature & date, and reports to the police that I wrote her anonymously because I am incoherent & crazy. The doctor will not be thus confused. I just want you to understand that I am not hiding in any shape or form -nor am I hiding my identity.

Also, there is no reason to be alarmed that I as a member of the public, found your residential address. That is because, in the UK, street addresses are largely public information and legitimately obtained. I have some experience in doing searches and found your details on one of the Companies House websites, where there is a likelihood to find doctors and other business people.

I can assure you that I do not know your email or phone, not obtainable under Data Protection. Also please take into account I do not have the mindset of UK citizens as they expect people especially women to do nothing on their own but take the assistance of agencies. I could do with some assistance which is why I am writing to you. They don't understand that I'm a human being. I am sick myself and getting little medical care

My purpose for writing to your home address is because your office secretary said she cannot tell me if my father is alive or dead, because I'm not allowed to contact my sister. I called back on 28th March when this lady said your practice manager Miss Lottie Blake was busy and to call back after several days. She was quite rude and hung up the phone. I wrote a complaint about her because she seems to think I'm dirt.

She does not have the authority to make that decision, which has to be given to her by the doctor.

Doctors are allowed to make discretionary decisions on releasing information. So, I ask you to help me by making a discretionary decision if you can release information- this information is about whether my father is alive or dead and about his medical condition.

My sister is not likely to tell me if my father dies. I feel this is our outrageous behavior. Doctors never give information if they are not convinced of their person's identity. If you feel I am the real party, then you as doctors have a right to decide to release such information

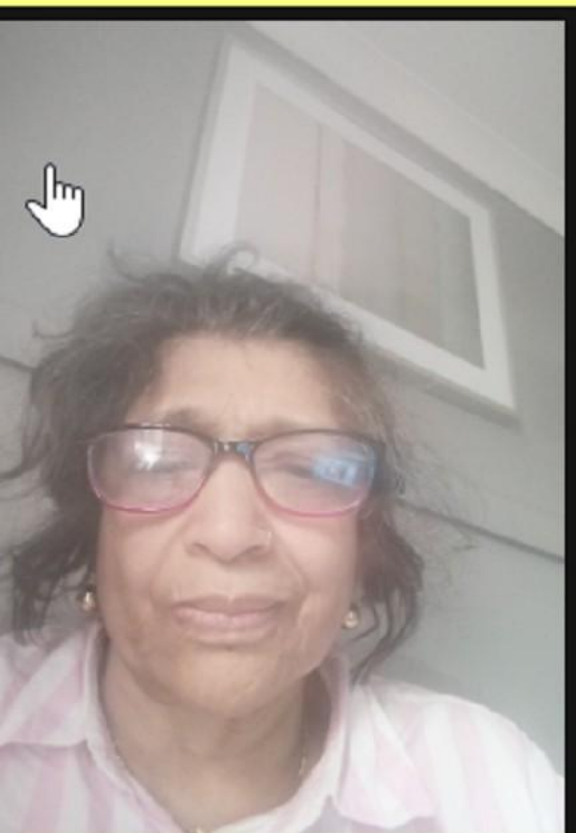
