Dear Theale medical receptionist(s)

I have forwarded your reply dated

There is no need to repeat the same sentence, and show that I am dirt. Whether my father can be treated as fully competent because he does not suffer from dementia is a legal matter I am not contesting legally. Disabled and elderly folks and are physically and mentally dependant morally too on their carers and start to see their captors as worthy of obedience. Yes under the law you cannot usually release medical records if a patient is deemed competent who has not signed consent. This law does not cover telling me if the patient is alive or dead. The question then is whether the patient themselves has instructed this doctor's office, Theale, that I should not be informed whether the father (himself) is alive or dead. I seriously doubt the doctor's office is obliged to cooperate with the patient in this way, but may do so as a courtesy to their patient. It is weird. I am only asking how he is and that he is alive and well. The second

matter is whether the patients stated near of kin Viju Wortley has asked you to shun me. You have no obligation to patients near of kin, except to follow the law, which is not a personal obligation to her. There is no law and no obligation of anyone to treat anyone like dirt. I do not expect any office to get involved with patients personal disputes certainly not those of near of kin. Let me tell you what happens with lady chains. A bloke worked as a teacher in Australia for 30 years and was very popular. One day the office got a voice on the phone from a man saying when he was 14 and this teacher was 15 and raped him. The office ladies sacked the old teacher immediately and he hanged himself. The point I am trying to make it, often prioritize safety and protection, with tunnel vision, not being logical nor considering the rights and human dignity of others. I have acknowledged two possible scenarios, (1)Viju Wortley told you I am dangerous scum (2)the patient himself told you such and such.

Once a lady says something to another lady, it becomes like a fact, and there are two ladies giving evidence. That is doubling the bad evidence against the accused or hated. When it passes through 1000 ears like Chinese

whispers, and the evidence against the accused or despised becomes gigantic. That is what I call the power of a lady chain. Its not right and mostly their lies revolve around safety and protection. Not all ladies are like that, but think logically and treat others properly.

I seek a resolution through each of the following from Theale medical surgery

Legal right to know if my father is alive or dead

Legal right to know how he is doing

If Viju Wortley requested my shunning

if Sr. Mr Venkataramanan requested my shunning(stronger case???)

For your information

On 25 April Viju Wortley signed for and refused registered post addressed to Mr Venkataramanan at her address

On 11 May Viju Wortley signed for and accepted registered post addressed to Mr. Venkataramanan at his (patients) registered address 19 Carston...

However she appears to have asked Royal Mail to delete her signature - not sure how that can be done-but was a day too late so I got the evidence.

Moreover the Royal Mail guy accidentally photographed the house entrance of 19 Carston G...which shows the house must be occupied.

I have no clue if the patient received his mail. I suppose Viju Wortley, who fabricated a harassment case against me in 2013, and set up an injunction she swore never to drop for life, feels scum like me does not need to know. This injunction does not cover Sr Mr K Venkataramanan, I can contact him if I wish.
