Community order

Order

The court makes a community order containing the requirements listed below. You must have complied with all the requirements by **4 November 2013** unless the requirement specifies a shorter period or date.

Requirement

1. **Curfew Requirement: Be under a curfew for 4 months. Start date 8 July 2013. End date 4 November 2013. Offender to remain at 26 Bourne Court, Soth Ruislip, Middlesex HA4 6SW between 21.00 - 07.00 daily.**
2. **The defendant is to be electronically monitored from 8 July 2013 to 4 November 2013 to ensure compliance with the following requirements: Curfew.**

Responsible Officer

The Responsible Officer for this order will be the electronic monitoring supervisor.

You must

- keep in touch with your Responsible Officer as that officer tells you
- tell your Responsible Officer if you change your address

Warning

If you do not comply with this order, you will be brought back to court. The court may then

- change the order by adding extra requirements
- pass a different sentence for the original offences. You could be sent to prison.

Note

You live within the area of the North Hampshire Magistrates' Court.

Either you or your Responsible Officer can ask the court to look again at this order. The court can then change it or cancel it if it feels that is the right thing to do. If you wish to do this you should get in touch with the supervising court.
